



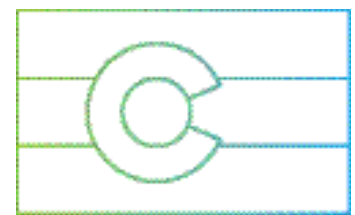
SENIOR FULL-STACK ENGINEER
